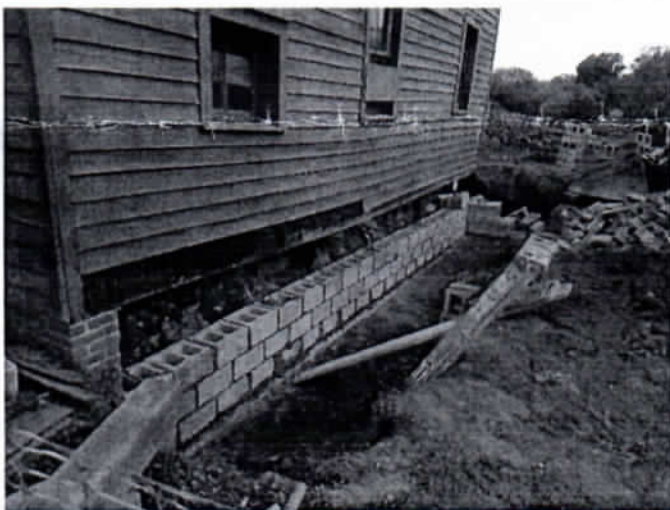
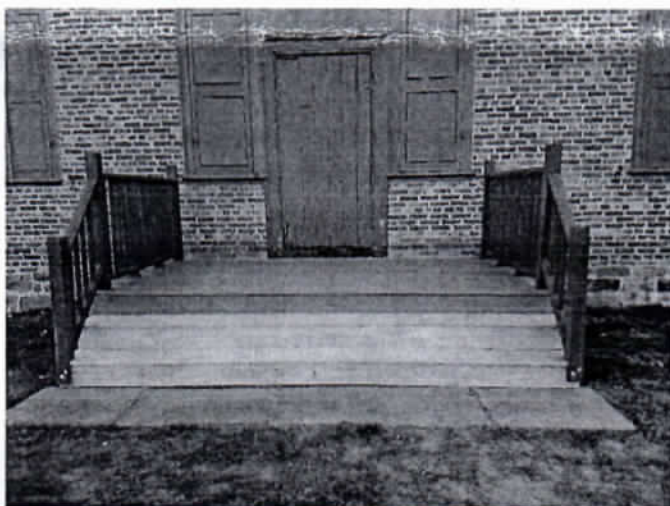


Recent Mansion Work

This September, work was done on the mansion's wooden addition. The foundation was rebuilt and the cellar access way was reworked in order to accommodate visitor friendly stairs to the basement, where kitchen restorations still need to be done around the recently restored cooking fireplace. Steps still need to be rebuilt, the wall needs to be restored, and the roof needs to be replaced.



Due to repeat frost heaves, the back porch footings had heaved the porch so that the back door was difficult to open and close, and the steps were unsafe. The deck was reset on new concrete piers that were set much deeper, and the steps were rebuilt. The grade around the back of the building was changed to shed water away from the building.
